Pencils, red correcting pen or pencil, section in a 3 ring binder, highlighter, colored pencils, book cover


### Grade 6 Tornadoes

### Grade 6 Koalas

- **One** three-ring binder large enough to hold all four core subjects: LA, Math, SS, and Science
- Index divider tabs to separate subjects (at least 5)
- Book covers (nonadhesive) **Paper book covers will be available at no charge in the MS offices and classrooms.**
- Pencils, an erasable pen (black or blue), a highlighter, a red pen for editing, colored pencils, two spiral notebooks for math, two pocket folders with fasteners, and adhesive reinforcements
- School-appropriate reading material (novels, magazines, etc.) is required in Koala classrooms
- Your child will need to have access to a dictionary
- **Please note: Notebook paper is provided in all classrooms. If you're purchasing some extra to have at home, please make sure it is the **standard, wide-ruled paper**. College-ruled paper may **not** be used by 6th graders.**

Recommended: 1 and 1/2 (1.5) inch three-ringed binder notebook, pencils


## Grade 8 Dragons

Required Supplies

- All students need "150 Exercises for Band" by Yaus. (Available from Mr. J @ \$6)
- ALL GRADES-4 small size pencils that fit in your instrument case.
- Woodwinds ALL GRADES- up to 6 reeds(no more) for your instrument.
- Trombones-slide cream and small water bottle (NO SLIDE OIL)
- Other Brass-valve oil and tuning slide lubricant.
